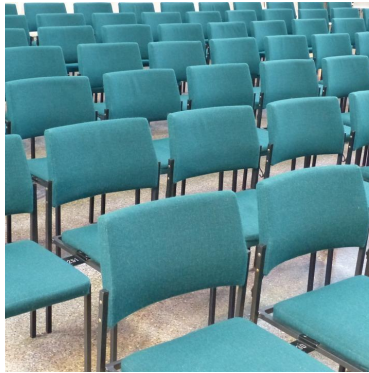




CAMPUS CARE TEAM

KID'S MINISTRY TEAM

KID'S MINISTRY CHECK-IN

Our mission is to provide a safe streamlined check in process for kids ministry.



Overview:

- Assign a parent a tag with a unique code required for child pick up.
- Determine if child takes communion and label the name sticker appropriately.
- Walk children to the correct classroom.
- Stay on the quad during service to assist the kids ministry team.



WEDNESDAY MENS DAY TEAM

Our mission is to leverage the skills God has given us to fix and improve existing church resources while fellowshiping with one another.



- **FELLOWSHIP**, we get together between 9:00 and 9:30 on Wednesday mornings to have some coffee and fellowship with other men.
- **DISCIPLESHIP**, we welcome everyone, even if they do not attend Ekklesia Church.
- **A LITTLE BIT OF WORK**, We get together to do maintenance work in God's house. Paint, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, tiling, landscaping, cleaning and making props for the pastors.

Where: in the Koine cafe

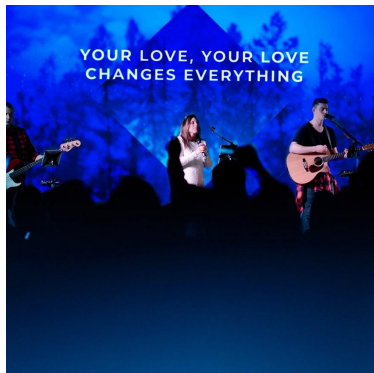
How: we do our best to do as much as we can with as little as we need. Your expertise will help us do whatever needs to be done.

Switchboard Operator

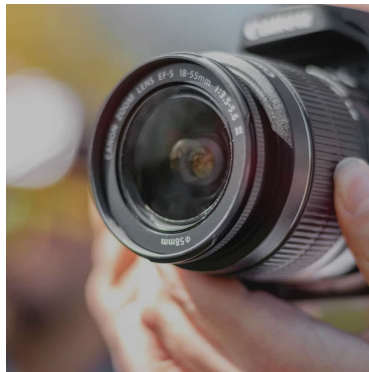
- Direct service livestreams to reach wider audience.

PARKING TEAM

Overview:

- Greet and wave at passing traffic from the church sidewalks to encourage visitors to stop by.
- Direct parking lot traffic flow.
- Provide warm and welcoming greetings to all guests who arrive and leave.
- Provide umbrellas or cover those coming and going in the rain to enable a pleasant church experience.



MEDICAL TEAM

Our mission is to provide immediate medical care and assistance to those in need prior to the arrival of emergency responders.



Overview:

- Provide first aid and assistance in the event of minor accidents or illnesses.
- Ensure first aid supplies and equipment are present.
- Provide training and information to staff members and teachers about first aid and accident related topics.
- Evaluate situations that may present medical or safety concerns for participants and make recommendations.
- Work in coordination with security team members and other teams at special events to provide oversight of conditions.
- Survey areas for potential hazards or safety concerns.

Requirements:

- Minimum of basic first aid and CPR or be willing to attend training and education to become minimally educated in these skills.



REACH

Our mission is to empower underserved youth with hope for a successful future by minimizing & negating cultural and academic inequities through the development of a Christian paradigm.



Commitment

- Inspiring youth with the knowledge of the Gospel and interaction with positive role models to instill a sense of hope in their future.

Responsibility

- Empowering youth to establish goals and follow through with commitments

Possibility

- Expanding perspectives to make students aware and assured of their God-given potential and of life's possibilities

Support

- Surrounding young people in a caring, inclusive learning environment



SECURITY TEAM

Our mission is to secure all private property and protect the congregation from disruptive people, physical and verbal violence, and physical harm by providing visual and physical deterrent.



Overview:

- Protect the congregation from disruptive people, physical violence, and verbal violence over the week.
- Walk perimeter of church facilities and parking lots.
- Confront patrons in a kind and respectful manner while able to physically restrain violent perpetrators.

Requirements:

- Physically and spiritually fit. (Titus 1:6-9 lifestyle)
- Regularly attend a discipleship group and worship services and monthly mission control.
- Able to obtain a CWP and pass a background check.
- Able to qualify with a firearm in accordance with SC Criminal justice academy Class 1 LEO course of fire.
- Must abstain from divisiveness in their private life and social media.



SOUL CARE TEAM

Our mission is to provide care, spiritual encouragement and coordinate physical and financial assistance to those in need.



Prayer

- Provide prayer support in person, by phone, or during services.

Baptism

- Provide baptisms during services and over the week.

Visitation

- Provide home, hospital, hospice, and funeral visits.

Respond

- Respond to emergency situations, such as suicide, domestic violence, and endangered child concerns.

Counsel

- Provide Biblically-based counseling/dispute resolution and referral information when professional counseling is needed.

Assist

- Evaluate physical and financial needs of struggling members to make recommendations to the elders about providing benevolence and assistance.



SPECIAL NEEDS MINISTRY

Our mission is to equip and disciple children, students, and adults with disabilities into the life and community of Ekklesia Christian Church.

Overview:

- Believe God has given each of us unique abilities and talents for His glory and our good.

Photographer

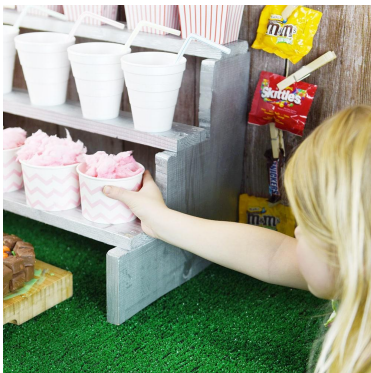
- Take pictures of smiles and game moments to share on social media for devotion and fellowship.

Concession Stand Helper

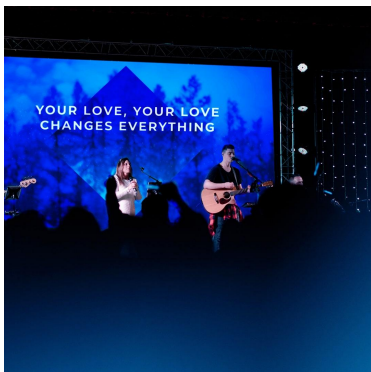
- Help purchase, prepare, and sell food during games.

Small Group Team

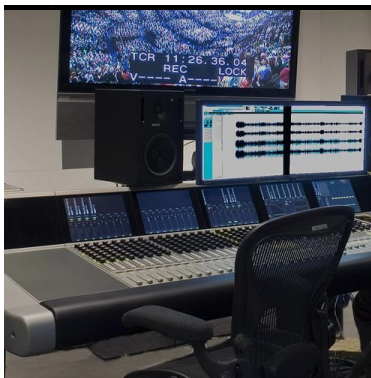
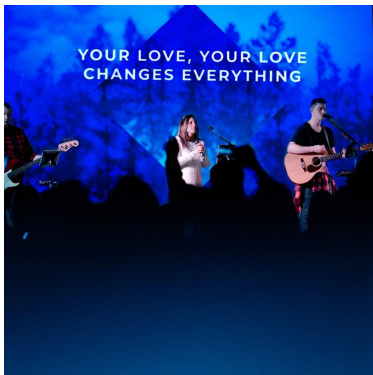
- Behind every great Small Group is a great leader, so our approach to Small Groups is to find the right leaders. Small Groups are the friends you grow, laugh, and serve with!
